	<b>Agency Response:</b> The WWAMI growth is occurring over two academic years, and UAA is well on its way to meeting the goal of expanding from 20 to 30 students. The first round of 5 additional students occurred with this past summer's new WWAMI cohort. UAA will add another 5 in the cohort of summer 2025. We cannot add them this coming summer due to space constraints. The FY24 Capital Budget included \$2 million in state funds for increasing WWAMI space. This effort is part of the first phase of our College of Health Workforce Expansion project with construction set to start this summer. After this, we will have cohorts of 30 from summer 2025 forward.
