Project Description/Justification:

The current SREB is more than 20 years old and has outlived its useable service life. The foundation is failing due to uneven settling. The building's insulation has deteriorated resulting in increased heating costs. A new building is needed to protect the snow removal equipment fleet from the elements and to provide a safe and cost effective environment for maintaining the vehicles.
