## **Brief Summary and Statement of Need:**

The department has a variety of existing facilities across the State that are utilized on a daily basis as enclosed secure storage (heated/cold) and other similar facilities that serve as workshops/equipment garages in support of field operations. Secure and safe storage of equipment and supplies, as well as safe indoor workshops/sealing facilities has become very problematic in many of the remote locations that the department maintains. Additionally, pilferage and theft is ever increasing as well as costs to maintain old and outdated facilities.
