Project Description/Justification:

In general, this program supports cooperation between federal and other agencies and the state, where the state has specialized knowledge or can combine work for a federal agency with work being done by the state to save costs.

In the past this has been used for special soils drilling analysis requested by the Forest Service in support of the Forest Highway Program, road maintenance for federal-owned roads and paving a state park road for the U.S. Park Service while the department's contractor was paving a state-owned road. This source has been used to construct projects for the Denali Commission, including Pile Bay Road Rehabilitation and Rural Dust Control Demonstration Project.

The majority of this request is for utility-related or non-federal activities. Utility facilities such as sewer and water lines, telephone lines, and natural gas pipelines are placed within the department's right-ofway under a permit process. preclude the need to dig up the roadway soon after project completion. The cooperative reimbursable authority is required to allow the department to bill entities for non-federal and non-state participating work.
