Project Description/Justification:

The existing asphalt in much of the areas that will be addressed will be over 20 years old by the time work begins and some is already 40 years old. The Pavement Condition Index (PCI) report shows that most of the pavement to be rehabilitated has a PCI below 50, far below the threshold at which rehabilitation is recommended. The project may include additional related work that is determined to be necessary during the design phase.
