Project Description/Justification:

Little Diomed has an unusually harsh environment. The local climate and sea spray takes a heavy toll on equipment. Currently, the community has a small, inadequate dozer they use to clear a temporary ice runway so that planes can land. Diomed has a Heliport which is very costly to use except for emergencies. This project will provide a snow removal equipment facility to substantially extend the life of the equipment and keep the runway open during winter months.
