Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The Health Center and Shower House at Camp Fire's resident camp on Kenai Lake will provide Alaskan youth with safe and accommodating health and first aid access and will also provide a shower and restroom facility. Camp Fire has a long term lease with the State of Alaska Department of Natural Resources and will be completing lease requirements for improved water and wastewater systems with the creation of the health station and shower house.

The facility will include a health center for medical staff to attend to children's health needs and provide a child rest area for youth who may be experiencing health concerns. This phase of the camp development plan is the final project of a \$3.25M development that will enable Camp Fire to increase the number of youth currently served.

Camp K provides special programs for Alaskan youth from a variety of organizations including: Grace Christian School, The American Diabetes Association, The Asthma and Allergy Foundation of Alaska, Denali Family Services, Girl Scouts and Alaska Children's Services. Camp K is also designated as an official "Operation Purple" camp site by the National Military Family Association providing youth whose parents are deployed with an educational summer camp experience.
