Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The FNSB is seeking a legislative grant to fund replacement of the oldest ambulance within the FNSB's ambulance fleet. The FNSB Department of Emergency Operations, Emergency Medical Services Division identified as one of its objectives the replacement of one ambulance.

This is an ongoing need as ambulance responses with patient transport continue to rise as the FNSB's population ages. In the FNSB's 2006/07 budget cycle there was an average of 6.26 ambulance responses per day with 1,527 responses requiring patient transport and 702 not requiring transport. By the 2009/10 budget cycle the response rate rose to to 7.17 ambulance responses per day with 1,809 requiring patient transport and 735 with no transport. Transport mileage billed has increased from 15,300 miles in 2006/07 to over 16,800 miles in 2009/10.

To keep up with this increase demand for services the FNSB needs to replace its oldest ambulance.

The FNSB is seeking a legislative grant to fund replacement of the oldest ambulance within the FNSB's ambulance fleet. The FNSB Department of Emergency Operations, Emergency Medical Services Division identified as one of its objectives for FY 2011/12 the replacement of one ambulance.

The FNSB has an aging fleet of ambulance and fire response equipment throughout the borough that needs to be replaced on a periodic basis. The FNSB fully supports requests from its fire service areas for new equipment.
