**Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

The Haines Borough must improve its boat harbor facilities. These and other proposed improvements are necessary to better serve and retain the commercial fishing fleet. Current plans call for initiating the South Portage Cove Harbor dredging boat launch and parking project to commence in FY14.

The Borough is working with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to conduct a geotechnical survey and analysis of soil conditions in the project area. This information is critical in determining if the ground can support a rubblemound breakwater.

The Borough's total funding request for Harbor improvements for FY13 is \$15,694,292. The Governor included \$4.5 million in his FY13 Capital Budget. Preliminary designs and budgets were prepared by PND Engineers, Inc. for several components of this project.

\*The Borough has requested funds from the Alaska Department of Fish and Game, Recreational Boating and Angler Access Grant Program to construct the boat launch ramp and boarding float.

**Project Timeline:**

Expenditures will begin immediately with the project being completed in FY 2015.

Adopted by a duly-constituted quorum of the Haines Borough Assembly on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2011.

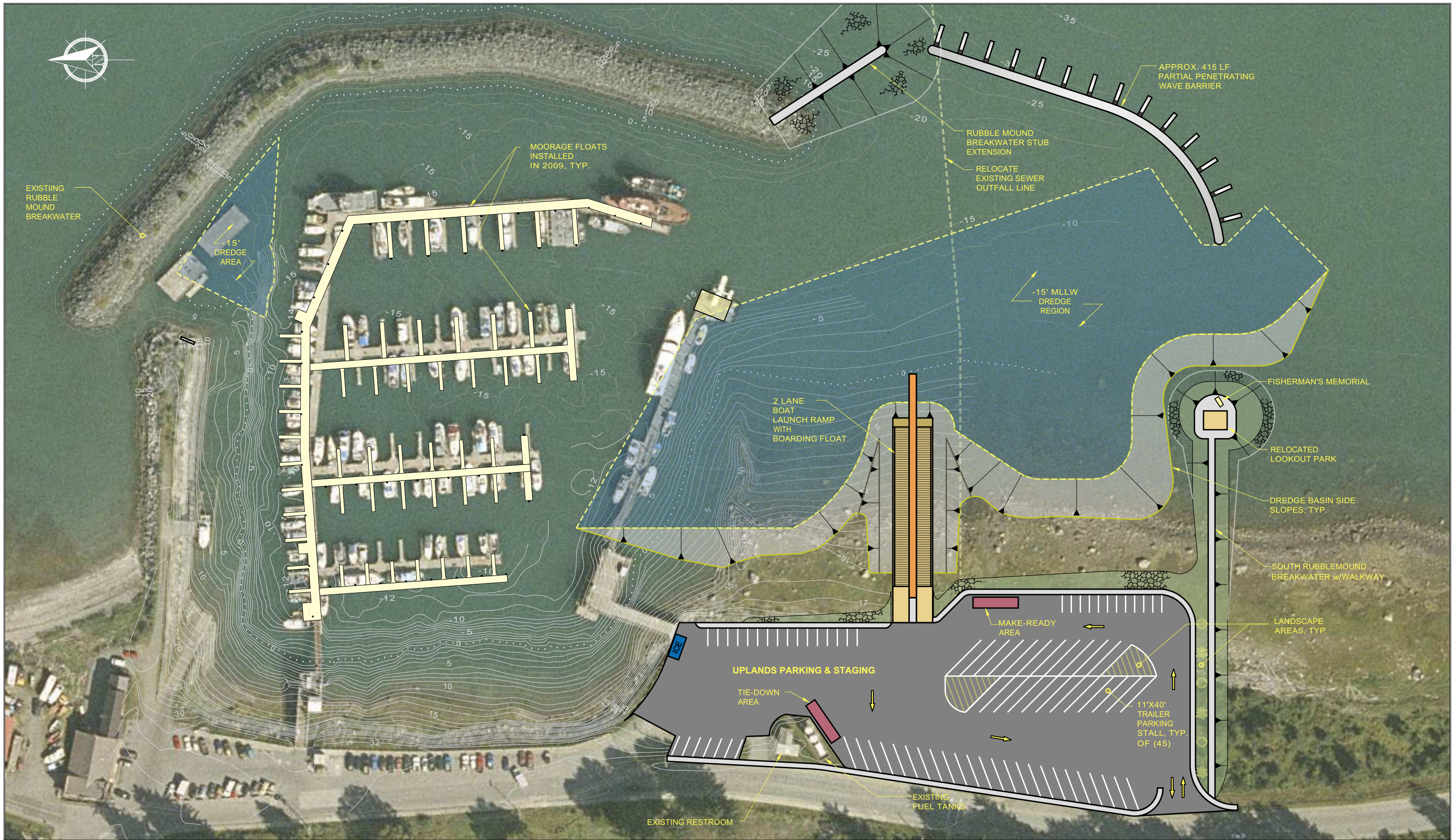

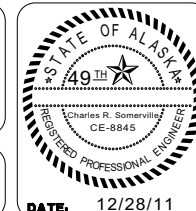

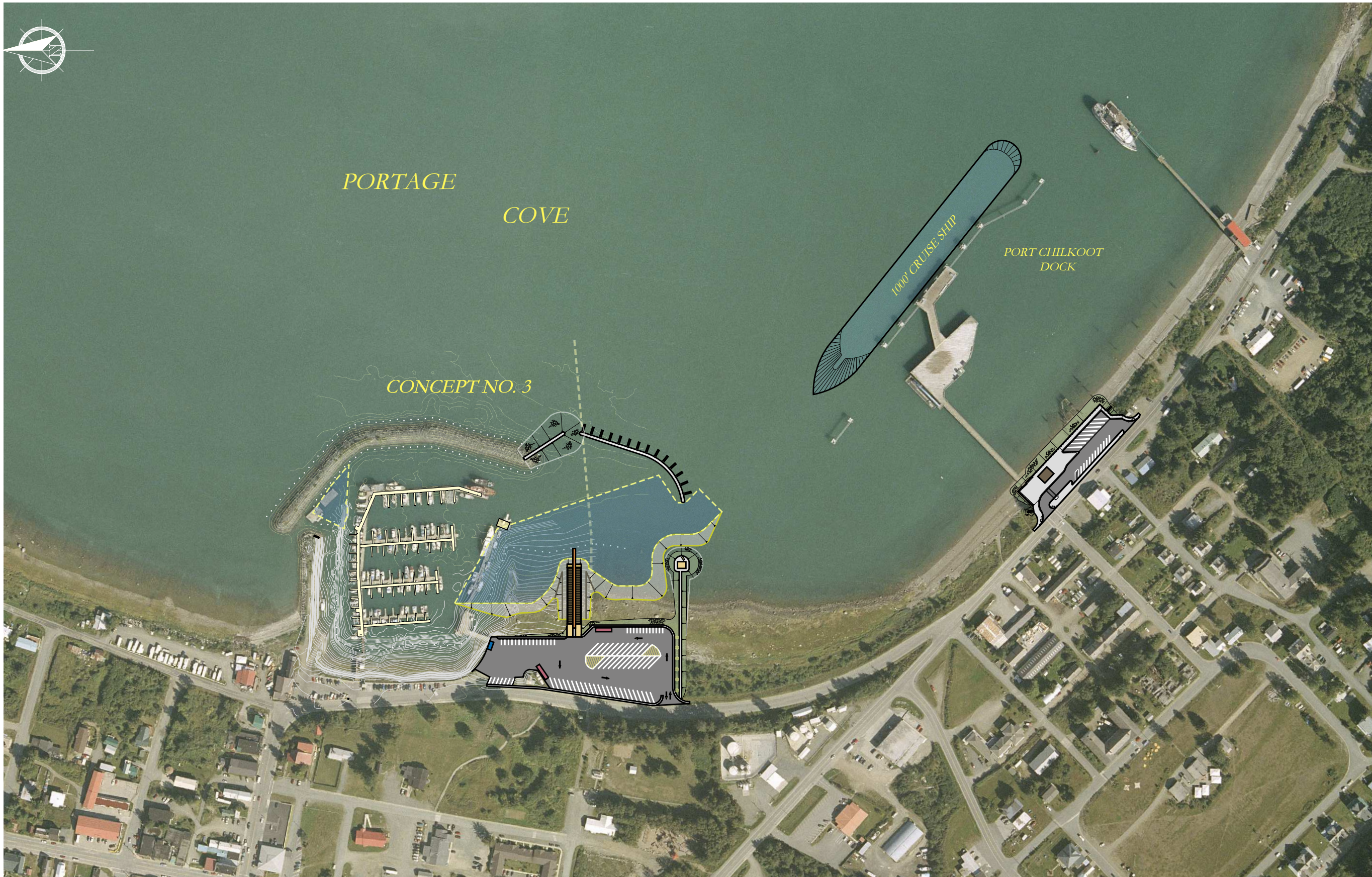
SHEET TITLE: GENERAL SITE PLAN

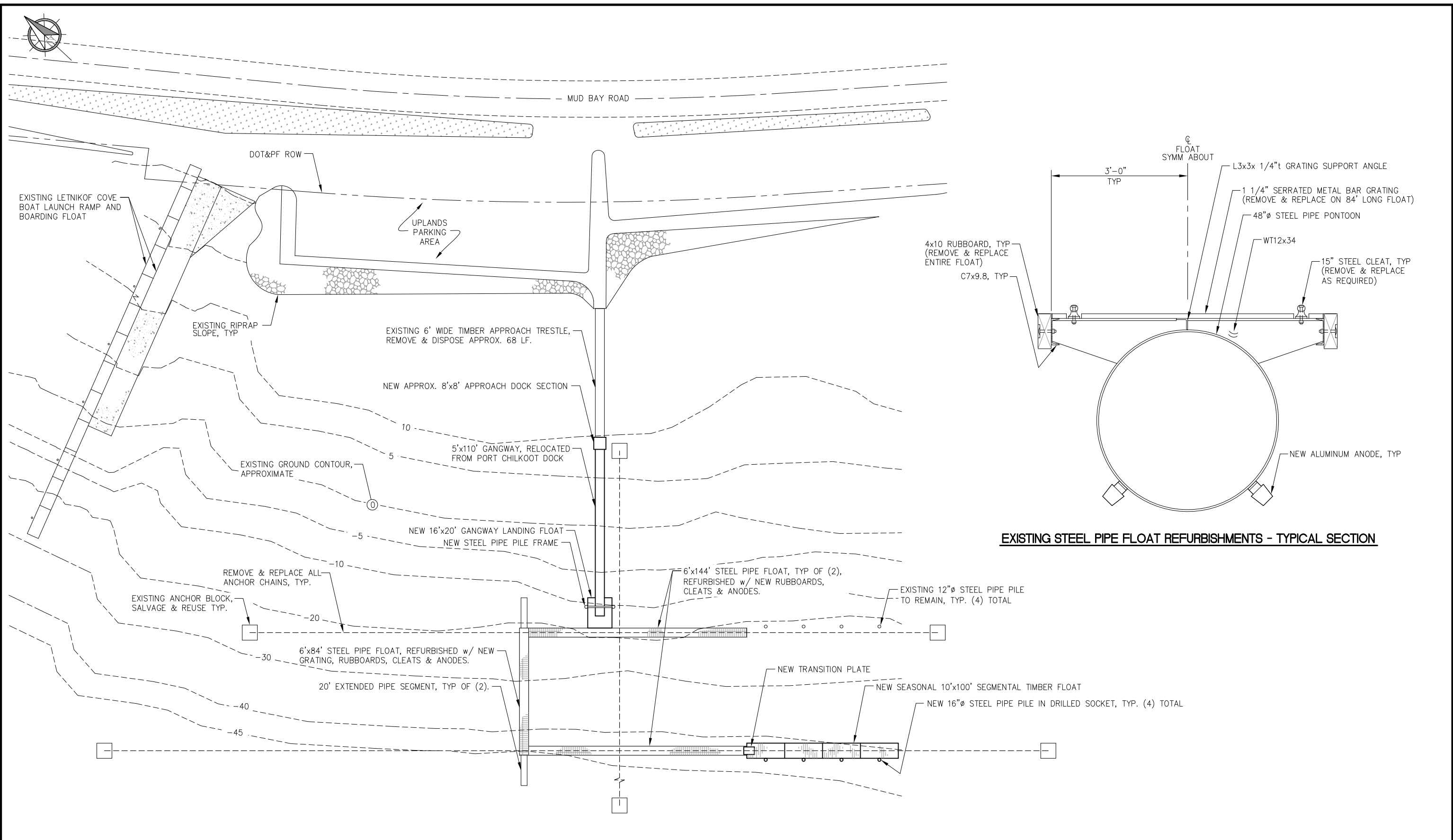
