**Project Description/Justification:**

The City of Wasilla completed the extension of Spruce Avenue to Church Street during the summer of 1999. This connection allows traffic to collect on Lucus Road and enter the Parks Highway at a signalized intersection. Lucus Road is now a through street and will function as a major collector accessing the Park Highway. Safety will be improved since residents of northwest Wasilla will be able to access the Parks Highway using the signal at Lucus Road.

This project contributes to the Department's Mission by reducing injuries, fatalities and property damage and by improving the mobility of people and
