## **Project Description/Justification:**

The existing State Office Building is located on Front Street in Nome. Multiple times in the past five years storms have flooded the building and caused severe damage. There has been severe corrosion of the metal wall studs on the seawall side. Asbestos is present throughout the building. Problems exist with windows, boilers, flooring, elevator, and the heating ventilation, and air conditioning system.

The Department of Administration will evaluate the agency and office space needs in Nome, as well as the leased and State-owned office space. This facility will provide agencies with adequate space and a sound working environment to deliver State services.
