The gym floor currently in use was poured almost 25 years ago and is need of replacement. This a rubberized poured floor and the gym lines would be repainted to match the existing lines.

Benefits if Project is Funded

This project would help with student achievement in physical education as well as help make our school a more safe environment for students, staff, and the community.

Impacts if Project is not Funded

Impacts if not completed the gym floor would continue to deteriorate - making for a more unsafe environment. Students safety would be compromised. Due to settling of the underlying cement, splits and cracks in the "rubber" surface have developed. Dirt and other material id difficult if not almost impossible to get out. This creates an unclean and unsafe environment for student to be on the floor for activities like exercise. Eventually the splits will probably make it unsafe for students to run on the floor.
