**Principal's Priority**                      2

Augment existing analog CCTV system with a Network Internet Protocol (IP) digital video security system. Installation will include video management software (VMS), megapixel cameras, client workstations, viewing monitors, video storage servers, Power Over Ethernet (POE) switches, encoders, cables, wiring, raceway, labor, testing, and setup to give the District an upgraded turnkey Network IP digital video security system. Network Video Encoders will be used to incorporate our existing analog CCTV cameras into the new digital IP video security system.  
Scope of work includes replacing 16 of the 32 analog cameras with IP cameras and adding additional 20 IP cameras for a total of 52 cameras. Due to the total camera count an additional server will be needed to support the camera system. Scope includes coverage for turf field area.
