Replace and purchase appropriate sized chairs and tables for children at Creekside Park. A number of the chairs have been gleaned from other sites, but we do not have enough chairs in each of the available sizes. Chairs purchased would be approximately 100 of each of the three size options of chairs, purchase additional trapezoid tables (50) for use in classrooms.

Benefits if Project is Funded

Studies show that students that d not have appropriate seating and desks do not perform as well as those that do. Our student should not be sitting in chairs that do not allow their feet to hit the floor. They need to be sitting with knees at 90 degrees and have desks/tables that allow for appropriate seating to better enable them to write and complete academics. Students with proper seating have the opportunity to be more successful in academic arenas.
