the purchase of these computers will allow a block of students to be assessed at the same time on computers. The screening takes about 45 minutes and will be conducted three times a year. In addition the computers will be put to daily for instruction. Currently Crossroads has a small number of laptops that are used for instruction, which means two classes cannot utilize the computers during the same class period due to the number of students in each class and the limited number of laptops. Without additional computers, instruction will be impacted on the days screening takes place and curriculum will continue to be impacted by computer access.
