This grant focuses on enhancing and replacing books and materials in the nonfiction area of the collection. Monthly statistics show nonfiction is the highest circulating section in the library. Because of the high usage, a large number of books simply need replacement due to poor condition. Other sections need further development with additional materials. While some selections are plentiful, others are scarce. Detailed collection analysis will be done in selected sections to determine gaps in information, reading levels, and condition of the materials. Results of the analysis will be shared with building staff members for collaboration and input.

**Benefits if Project is Funded**

Gladys Wood's library will be able to engage more students in reading. The updated library will benefit teachers in improved materials for reading instruction. Without this grant, the library will not have the means to increase its reading materials nor replace the books that are in poor condition.
