This funding will provide for the purchase two trailers with foam producing capability. Currently the fire department uses a converted water tender to carry 2500 gallons of foam. The foam is used primarily to protect the bulk fuel storage fires at the Port of Anchorage, though the foam can be used to extinguish fires fed by fuel. The converted water tender requires additional maintenance. The foam trailers are simpler, require significantly less maintenance and are designed for this purpose

Project Timeline:

It is the fire department's intention to purchase this apparatus at the end of FY 2012 and receive delivery approximately 12 months later.
