Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The Steese Volunteer Fire Department has entered in an agreement with the Fairbanks North Star Borough to add on an Emergency Opoerations Center to our facility. The EOC is a borough project with construction projected to begin in the summer of 2012. Funding for that project was secured through a Homeland Security Grant. However the grant does not cover paving of the parking lot or driveway. With increased use of our facility with the new EOC center, traffic will pose a problem for our neighbors due to the gravel and dust conditions that will ensue. Our project is to cover paving of the driveway, all parking areas, and add a cncrete pad in front of the bays for fire appartaus parking. The goal of the Steese FSA Commission is to have a facility that is neighborhood firendly and also improve our property for long term use. Sharing our facility will bring challenges, but in a era of reduced financing, agencies coming together to share resources ultimately benefits all.
