# Denali Borough - Anderson School Heating Fuel Storage Tank Replacement

**Brief Project Description:**

Replace Anderson School heating fuel storage tanks. These tanks are single wall fuel tanks and containment area is inadequate.

**Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

The Anderson School heating fuel storage tanks are a hazard to the community and the school. These two tanks are single wall 3000 gallon fuel tanks that do not have anti-siphon valves installed. They are sitting on 4x4 wood posts that are inadequate as a base. The containment that these tanks are sitting in has rotted due to continued exposure to the sun during the long summer days in Alaska. They do not meet the minimum standards set forth by the EPA or the DEC for fuel storage.

DBSD would like to replace these tanks with two 3000 gallon double wall fuel storage tanks that have leak detection and meet all EPA and DEC guidelines for fuel storage. These new tanks will protect the ground water of the Anderson community from being contaminated from a fuel spill.

**Project Timeline:**

Fuel tanks would be ordered as soon as funds are available. The tanks would take approx. 6 weeks to be fabricated. Immediately after tanks are constructed they will be installed.
