For the past three years the primary funding source for statewide FIRST Robotics infrastructure has been the U.S. Dept. of Defense,				
Office of Technology Transfer, and the OSD National Defense Education Program. Significant private sector support comes from BP and				
GCI, with smaller contributions from other corporate sponsors.				

#### **Detailed Project Description and Justification:**


Robotics in Alaska is gaining momentum. Alaska now leads the nation in FIRST LEGO League and FIRST Tech Challenge, with the highest per capita participation in the United States. During the 2011-12 season approximately 2,200 students will participate in four FIRST Robotics programs, mentored by over 225 adult coaches and 200+ volunteers who donate over 1600 hours of time at tournaments. This is made possible by the statewide coordination and leadership of the STEM AK program of the Juneau Economic Development Council, with funding from the U.S. Department of Defense, National Defense Education Program, and private sector.

Given current and projected Department of Defense budget cuts, state funding is needed to sustain the statewide infrastructure for FIRST Robotics in Alaska. Capital funding allows time to pursue other foundations, corporate sponsors, and longer term financing options.

FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology) is a national and world-wide program designed to inspire young people's interest and participation in science and technology. It offers a continuum of challenges, from Kindergarten through high school:

- Jr. FIRST LEGO League (Jr. FLL) for grades K-3
- FIRST LEGO League (FLL) for ages 9-14,
- FIRST Tech Challenge (FTC), introductory high school robotics, and

- FIRST Robotics (FRC), high school robotics

As Operational Partner for FIRST in Alaska, JEDC is the main liaison with the national FIRST office, and coordinates all activities in the state. This includes awarding financial support to rookie teams, leading regional coach trainings, organizing student workshops, and overseeing tournaments in the state. In 2011-2012 there were 4 Jr. FIRST LEGO League expos, 10 FIRST LEGO League tournaments including one virtual tournament, and 6 FIRST Tech Challenge (FTC) tournaments. Regional and virtual tournaments are proving a cost effective means of keeping travel costs low for teams, who cover this cost through local fund raising and school district contributions.

Corporate partners include BP and GCI, with additional support from CH2MHill and UAF Space Grant. In addition, partnerships forged with the Girl Scouts of Alaska, 4-H, the Anchorage Museum, the Alaska State Fair, the Challenger Learning Center and Alaska Space Grant have strengthened the program's community base, and broadened participation across the state. Funding for FIRST Tournaments is also provided on a local and regional basis by Flint Hills and other donors, along with significant in-kind contributions by University of Alaska and local school districts.

Enthusiasm for FIRST LEGO League (ages 9-14) is growing. 2011-2012 season recap shows:

- Over 1200 students participated, with
- 45% of participants are girls, as compared to the national average of ~ 30%, on
- 148 teams (13% growth), in 94 schools
- In 50 communities (38% growth over previous year), representing 25 School Districts
- The season included 8 regional qualifiers, a virtual tournament, and 2 state championships.
- Tournaments were held in Juneau, Anchorage, Fairbanks, Bethel, and Kenai
- FLL is proving successful in both remote village and large urban schools

FIRST LEGO League (FLL) teams are judged in four categories: Research Project, Teamwork, Robot Design and Programming, and Robot Performance. Each year students are tasked with researching and proposing solutions to a current real world challenge. This project based approach offers a rich opportunity to address issues grounded in student experience and local context.

STEM competitions like FIRST Robotics offer an opportunity for students to push themselves to excel in a fun and exciting way that is often difficult to reproduce in the traditional school setting. These competitions build a community of students interested in science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) in the same way traditional sports competitions build school spirit. In addition, FIRST places a premium on creating a culture of gracious professionalism, fair play and hard work.

National studies have tracked students and found that participants in FIRST Robotics are 50% more likely to attend college, and three times as likely to major specifically in engineering. They have access to \$15 million in college scholarships. Once in college, these students are ten times as likely to have an internship with a company, and young women are four times more likely to go on to studies in science and engineering. We are just beginning to see the results of earlier student participation in FIRST LEGO League as this cohort graduates from high school. For example, a young man who participated in FLL in middle school and continued onto high school robotics at East High School, is now successfully enrolled in UAF's engineering program and recently interned with BP.

State funding is needed to sustain the infrastructure and continue the momentum of FIRST Robotics in Alaska. It is an investment in workforce development and Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) capacity.

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#### **Project Timeline:**

Expenditures will begin July 1, 2012 and continue through two fiscal years.

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### RESOLUTION of the Board of Directors in support of State of Alaska Funding for *FIRST* Robotics Resolution 01-12

**WHEREAS**, according to the American College Testing (ACT) program, of the students of Alaska's high school class of 2010 who took the ACT test, 54% did not meet college-readiness benchmark in mathematics and 69% did not meet the college-readiness benchmark for science. *(ACT, The Condition of College & Career Readiness – Class of 2010, Alaska)*; and

**WHEREAS**, U.S. jobs that demand technical training are growing five times faster than those requiring no technical training. *(National Math & Science Initiative)*; and

**WHEREAS**, by 2018, it is projected that 90% of U.S. occupations will require either a bachelor's degree or a combination of college-level technical courses and employer sponsored technical training. *(US Bureau of Labor Statistics)*; and

**WHEREAS,** Governor Sean Parnell has recognized the importance of increasing student achievement, by signing into law the Alaska Performance Scholarship, which will provide incentive for students to take a more rigorous curriculum, including four years each for courses in math and science, to better prepare students for college, job training and career success; and

**WHEREAS**, Alaska employers have increasingly expressed concern about the lack of Alaska job seekers with Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) skills; and

**WHEREAS**, since 2007, Juneau Economic Development Council (JEDC) has developed a robust program to support STEM education in 25 school districts across the state, which includes teacher professional development, an array of summer and after-school enrichment programs, developing and subsidizing the cost of over 1,000 classroom science kits; and

**WHEREAS,** JEDC is the operational partner for *FIRST* Robotics in Alaska, responsible for statewide coordination and support for the continuum of robotics programs, including Jr. *FIRST* LEGO League, *FIRST* LEGO League, *FIRST* Technology Challenge, and *FIRST* Robotics, and under whose leadership, Alaska has become a national leader, with the highest per capital participation in FIRST LEGO League and FIRST Tech Challenge in the nation; and

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Department of Defense funding for K-12 STEM Outreach has declined and these cuts threaten the future of these programs in Alaska;

Juneau Economic Development Council Board of Directors Resolution 01-12 Page 1 On this 1<sup>st</sup> day of February 2012, the Board of Directors of the Juneau Economic Development Council hereby requests funding of \$280,000 from the State of Alaska for *FIRST* Robotics to inspire, engage and train a new generation of students proficient in STEM skills and prepared for the projected 8,000 STEM job openings in Alaska.
