Funding Details:

Soldotna Senior Center has held fundraising events for 3 years to help fund an emergency backup generator. To date SASCI has raised \$45,000.00 for the generator and is respectfully requesting Legislative funding of \$58,000.00 for the project.

Detailed Project Description and Justification:

An emergency backup generator is of great need and very high priority on SASCI's strategic planning to provide uninterrupted services fo 770 area seniors. Seniors (especially homebound and disabled individuals) that rely on SASCI services would be assured they would continue to receive necessary services such as congregate meals, homebound meals, transportation and support services that they cannot provide for themsleves. The emergency backup generator is a Kohler 50 KVA, LP that is self starting, and auto-switching unit capable of providing adequate power for and extended period of time. With an emergency backup generator SASCI would also become a primary shelter that would provide an ADA equipped shelter, meals, homebound meals, showers and critical transportation to the general populace during an emergency or catashrophic event. The backup emergency generator is in advanced planning and engineering with Raven Electric, Inc.

Project Timeline:

The time line for ordering, receipt and installation of the emergency backup generator is during the construction season of 2012. Expenditures would occur between June and September of 2012.
