# Know the Warning Signs

**Most suicidal people don't really want to die; they just want their pain to end.**

## Watch for these signs.

A previous suicide attempt

Current talk of suicide or making a plan

Strong wish to die or a preoccupation with death

Giving away prized possessions

Signs of depression, such as moodiness, hopelessness, withdrawal

Increased alcohol and/or other drug use

Hinting at not being around in the future or saying good-bye

These warning signs are especially noteworthy in light of:

a recent death or suicide of a friend or family member

a recent break-up with a boyfriend or girlfriend, or conflict with parents

news reports of other suicides by young people in the same school or community

Other key risk factors include:

Readily accessible firearms

Impulsiveness and taking unnecessary risks

Lack of connection to family and friends (no one to talk to)

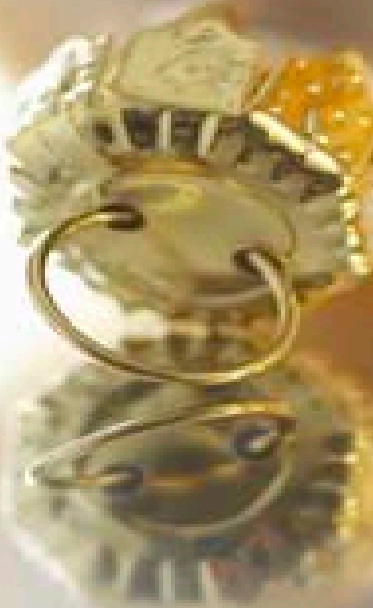
