Detailed Project Description and Justification:

A large percentage of our targeted population will be youth involved in Juvenile Justice system.

At risk youth are in need to mentorship training beyond formal education (school) and the systematic training obtained in a facility. Our 12-month program provides an opportunity for life skills training activities that will shape participants way of thinking about self:

- One-on-one mentorship/guidance
- Personal accountability
- Personal goals and aspiration, i.e., "hope" development
- Job shadowing
- Professional development
- Job training
- Personal assessment/awareness of self

Project Timeline:

The program session are scheduled across a 12-month period. Participants are expected to graduate after the 12-month period but can be enrolled for subsequent sessions. An estimated \$8000 will be needed each month to complete program activities. An estimated 30% is needed for the program's administrative staff costs. All other funding are direct costs to fund program activities.
