## **Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

The Muldoon Road/Glenn Highway Interchange has become increasingly dangerous and congested with traffic from the combination of the new shopping structure at Tikahtnu Commons, the VA clinic, access to Joint Base Elmendorf-Richardson and Bartlett High School. Semi-trailer trucks servicing the hospital and shopping area must exit the Glenn to reach their destination. Traffic is consistently backed up on to the highway. This area is also a safety concern for pedestrians and students attending Bartlett High School. The Department of Transportation recognizes the need to address these concerns through a traffic, safety and pedestrian study in order to propose a long term fix.
