This is a new FY2013 capital project due to the submission and approval of the new 2012 - 2015 Statewide Transportation Improvements Program (STIP), which occurred after the December 15th release of the Governor's budget. Using the Material Site Inventory, material sites will be screened to select those that are a priority for determining storm water regulatory requirements. The priority sites will be visited to determine the site drainage and nature of discharge points. During the field visit, information will be gathered that is required to produce a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP). SWPPPs will be developed for those sites that are determined to need storm water permit authorization.
