Rehabilitate approximately 10 miles of existing logging roads. Project would provide road connectivity between the Gravina Island road system and Vallenar Bay. The Ketchikan Airport Ferry currently provides vehicular access between Ketchikan and Gravina Island. Project would provide road access to State and other public land on Gravina Island. A ferry terminal at Vallenar Bay could reduce travel time for the IFA ferry to Hollis by 30%.
