Column Definitions

Adj Base (FY12 Adjusted Base) - FY2011 Management Plan less one-time items, plus FY2012 adjustments for position counts, funding transfers, line item transfers, and additions for statewide items (risk management and most salary and benefit increases). The Adjusted Base is the "first cut" of the FY2012 budget; it is the base to which the Governor's and the Legislature's increments, decrements, and fund changes are added.

Senate (FY12 Senate) - The version of the FY2012 operating bill adopted by the Senate.
