The House Finance Subcommittee on the Department of Environmental Conservation Budget submits an operating budget for Fiscal Year 2014 as follows:

Budget Action

The House Finance Subcommittee on the Department of Environmental Conservation Budget held four meetings. Each agency division provided excellent and forthright presentations on missions, core services, performance measures, accomplishments, challenges, budget trends since Fiscal Year 2005, the status of Fiscal Year 2013 budget changes, the Fiscal Year 2014 budget request, tsunami debris relief, the status of the Oil and Hazardous Substance Release Prevention and Response Fund, and more.

The subcommittee accepted the Governor's amended proposal – including \$145,200 UGF for administrative core services relating to risk management, personnel, information services, and other related costs – with the following adjustments:

- Environmental Health appropriation, Drinking Water allocation Accept half of the increment to allow the agency to implement two new drinking water rules under the federal Safe Drinking Water Act. Total cost: \$175,000 UGF.
- Water appropriation, Water Quality allocation Accept half of an increment to help the agency, under the Alaska Pollutant Discharge Elimination System, to assume responsibility for oil and gas wastewater discharge permitting from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.
 Total cost: \$271,500 UGF, \$7,000 DGF. New position: one PFT.

Total costs: \$453,500 – one half of the Governor's \$907,000 request.
