The House Finance Subcommittee on the University of Alaska Budget submits an operating budget for Fiscal Year 2014 as follows:

Budget Action

The House Finance Subcommittee on the University of Alaska Budget held four meetings on January 29 and February 5, 12, and 19, 2013. It reviewed missions, core services, performance measures, accomplishments, challenges, budget trends since Fiscal Year 2005, the Fiscal Year 2014 budget request, and more. It heard from University of Alaska President Patrick Gamble, Chancellor John Pugh of the University of Alaska Southeast, Chancellor Tom Case of the University of Alaska Anchorage, Chancellor Brian Rogers of the University of Alaska Fairbanks, and David Teal, director of the Legislative Finance Division.

The subcommittee accepted the Governor's amended proposal – including funding for University of Alaska contractual salary and health increases and reverting to a single appropriation budget structure – with the following adjustments:

- Provided an unallocated increment of \$407,800 Unrestricted General Funds and \$50,000 General Fund/Mental Health in the University of Alaska's Budget Reductions/Additions Systemwide allocation that the University may distribute at its own discretion. (To see how this figure was derived, see the attached Legislative Finance worksheet.)
- This unallocated increment is in lieu of approval of individual Unrestricted General Fund increments requested by the Governor.
- Base funding of \$250,000 General Funds is included for the second year of the Institute of Social and Economic Research (ISER) Alaska Education Policy (Fiscal Year 2013-Fiscal Year 2014).

These actions result in a reduction of \$2,409,200 Unrestricted General Funds to the Governor's Amended Fiscal Year 2014 Operating Budget Request.

Item of Interest

The Chair plans to bring the following amendment to the full House Finance Committee:

• Reducing the Fiscal Year 2014 budget request by \$40,000,000 in unrealized University Receipts (Designated General Funds) – sometimes known as "hollow receipts."

It is the intent of the legislature that future budget requests of the University of Alaska for unrestricted general funds move toward a long-term goal of 125 percent of actual University Receipts for the most recently closed fiscal year."

"It is the intent of the legislature that the University of Alaska submits a Fiscal Year 2015 budget that includes a debt service allocation or an effective alternative that attains that goal."
