The department requests a fund source change from federal authority to funds from the fee accounts of the Alaska Clean Water and Drinking Water Funds (ACWF/ADWF).

Each drinking water and wastewater project loan issued by the Municipal Grant and Loan program is charged a 0.5% administrative fee. This adjustment is a change from federal authority to funds from those fee accounts (Alaska clean water administrative operating account (AS 46.03.034(a)(1)) in the Alaska clean water administrative fund (AS 46.03.034) and the Alaska drinking water administrative operating account (AS 46.03.038(a)(1)) in the Alaska drinking water administrative fund (AS 46.03.038).) This will allow the department to access those fees to cover expenses associated with managing the loans. Expenditures from the fee account will be offset by reduced spending from federal ACWF/ADWF capitalization grant set-asides. This adjustment will maintain the department's capacity to administer the programs.

Money received in payment of fees charged by the department (a fixed fee of one-half of one percent of the total amount of financial assistance disbursed) and earnings on the Alaska clean water administrative fund are deposited in the Alaska clean water and drinking water administrative income accounts and may be used to pay for the department's operational and administrative costs necessary to manage the Alaska clean water/drinking water fund and the Alaska clean water/drinking water administrative fund and for such other purposes permitted by federal law. The fees have been collected to be used to maintain the loan processing capacity as federal receipts decline.

Column Definitions

Adj Base (FY15 Adjusted Base) - FY2014 Management Plan less one-time items, plus FY2015 adjustments for position counts, funding transfers, line item transfers, temporary increments (IncT) from prior years, and additions for statewide items (risk management and most salary and benefit increases). The Adjusted Base is the "first cut" of the FY2015 budget; it is the base to which the Governor's and the Legislature's increments, and fund changes are added.

Gov (FY15 Governor Request) - Includes FY2015 Adjusted Base plus the Governor's operating budget bill requests for increases (increments), decreases (decrements), fund source changes, and language transactions.
