March 12, 2014

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Senate Finance Budget Subcommittee for the Department of Law submits a recommended operating budget for FY2015 to the Senate Finance Committee as follows:

Unrestricted General Funds (UGF)	\$59,332,300
Designated General Funds	\$2,727,900
Other Funds	\$29,293,900
Federal Funds	\$1,004,300
TOTAL	\$93,458,400

BUDGET ACTION:

The Senate Finance Budget Subcommittee for the Department of Law analyzed all of the Governor's budget transactions. The following are budget action highlights:

- Recommends authorizing \$1,100,000 less general funds and \$1,100,000 more in other funds within the Oil, Gas and Mining components contained in the Civil Division
- Establishes the Oil, Gas and Mining increments for outside counsel as a One-Time-Increment.
- Fully funds the remainder the Governor's FY15 requested budget.


