16Adj Base (FY16 Adjusted Base) - FY2015 Management Plan less one-time items, plus FY2016 adjustments for position counts, funding transfers, line item transfers, temporary increments (IncT) from prior years, and additions for statewide items (risk management and most salary and benefit increases). The Adjusted Base is the "first cut" of the FY2016 budget; it is the base to which the Governor's and the Legislature's increments, decrements, and fund changes are added.

16GovEndorsed (16Governor's Endorsed Bdgt 2/5) - The Governor's endorsed budget as of February 5, 2015. Includes the December 15th budget submission and 2/5/15 budget Governor's budget submission,
