<u>Intent</u> It is the intent of the legislature that the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development submit a written report to the co-chairs of the Finance Committees and the Legislative Finance Division by October 1, 2019, that indicates (1) the amount each community in the state that participates in the National Flood Insurance Program has paid into the program since 1980, the amount that has been paid out of the program for claims, and the average premium for a home in a special flood hazard area; (2) for the top five states that have received more in funds paid out than premiums paid into the National Flood Insurance Program since 1980, the amount paid into the program, the amount of claims paid out of the program, and the average premium for a home in a special flood hazard area; and (3) the number of properties in each community in the state that has been added to a special flood hazard area through mapping efforts by the Federal Emergency Management Agency since 2010.
