This appropriation is for multi-year funding covering FY2020 and FY2021 for staff, travel, research, and contracting costs. It will fund the production of a comprehensive report to the Governor and the Legislature on the status of investigations of missing and murdered Indigenous women and girls in Alaska. The report should provide statistical data on the cases and analysis of the response of law enforcement over the previous ten fiscal years, a deeper historical summary, and recommendations of policy changes and funding needs in order to address this epidemic.

This is a placeholder budget and will be amended by Governor Dunleavy on the 30th day of the 2019 legislative session.
