### SUBCOMMITTEE MEETINGS:

The House Finance Budget Subcommittee for the Department of Commerce, Community & Economic Development held four meetings with the Department during the review of the FY20 budget request.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

The House Finance Budget Subcommittee for the Department of Commerce, Community & Economic Development submits a recommended operating budget for FY20 to the House Finance Committee as follows:

From the FYI 9 Management Plan, the House Subcommittee recommendation reflects a total decrease in Unrestricted General Funds of \$2,744.5 a 27.2 percent decrease. It also represents a 17% decrease from the FY 20 Adjusted Base.

### SUBCOMMITTEE AMENDMENTS:

The following Subcommittee budget amendments are submitted to the House Finance Committee for consideration:

1) **Department-Wide** Travel-delete 32.7 1004 UGF, 321.5 DGF, 86.4 1002 Fed and 366.5 Other

This amendment deletes travel for the department in the amounts shown above.

- Alaska Seafood Marketing Institute add 209.6 Other
   This amendment restores the funding to the Alaska Seafood Marketing Institute.
- 3) Executive Administration -add 3.3 1004 UGF
  This amendment adds funds to the Office of Information Technology for salary adjustments billed to agencies.
- 4) Alaska Gasline Development Corporation delete 450.0 1235 AGDC-LNG This amendment reduces the personal services to reflect the pay differential of the current Executive Director.
- 5) Community and Regional Affairs delete 450.0 I 004 UGF and add 450.0 1235 AGDC-LNG

This amendment deletes unrestricted general funds and replaces it with funds from the AGDC-LNG. Funds are available due to the reduction taken in AGDC-LNG for personal services.

- 6) Community and Regional Affairs -delete 1,000.0 1004 UGF
  This amendment deletes the funding for local government support and services. This funding reflects the FY!8 actual expenditures.
- 7) Economic Development- delete 229.8 1200 DGF and add 229.8 1004 UGF This amendment is a fund somce change from vehicle rental tax to unrestricted general funds.
- 8) Economic Development-delete 243.41004 UGF, delete 173.3 1002 Fed Rcpts., delete 182.2 Other and delete 2 positions.
  - This amendment deletes economic development funding and 2 positions.
- Insurance Operations add 277.0 Fed Rcpts.
   This amendment adds federal authority for insurance market initiatives in Alaska.
- 10) Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office adds 1,574.4 1005 GF/Prgm.

  This amendment restores marijuana regulation funding from license receipts.
- 11) Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office- delete 12.9 1004 UGF and add 12.9 1005 GF/Prgm.

This replaces unrestricted general funds with general fund program receipts.

12) Alaska Energy Authority- 381.8 1169 DGF

This amendment leaves Power Cost Equalization Endowment funding for projects approved by the Alaska Energy Authority.

- 13) Alaska Seafood Marketing Institute 300.0 I002 Fed Rcpts.

  This amendment maximizes federal receipts available from the USDA Market Access Program and Cochran Fellowship Program.
- 14) Economic Development- add 713.2 1004 UGF, add 106.8 1200 DGF and delete 713.2 1004 UGF, delete 106.8 1200 DGF

  This amendment returns funding for the 3 positions transferred to the Governor's office, then deletes the funding and the 3 positions as the Governor's office can absorb economic development functions with their existing resources.
- 15) Delete Wordage "At the discretion of the Office of Management and Budget funding may be transferred between all appropriations in the Depaitment."
